COMMISSIONER WORTMAN PRESENTED AN UPDATE ON INFORMATION PRESENTED AT A RECENT LEGISLATIVE MEETING. HE ALSO REPORTED THE CENTRAL CABARRUS VIKINGS 3A BASKETBALL WON THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP; AND FIVE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ROBOTICS TEAMS EARNED WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BIRTH. COMMISSIONER WORTMAN ANNOUNCED THE ACTIVE LIVING AND PARKS COMMISSION IS IN NEED OF APPLICANTS FROM THE MIDLAND AND NORTHWEST PLANNING AREAS. THE SENIOR GAMES REGISTRATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED THROUGH MARCH 24TH. ARCHERY CLASSES AT CAMP TN SPENCER ARE BEGINNING ON THE THIRD FRIDAY OF EACH MONTH.

COMMISSIONER STRANG PRESENTED AN UPDATE FROM THE HCCBG (HOME AND COMMUNITY CARE BLOCK GRANT) COMMITTEE- THERE WILL BE A SLIGHT INCREASE FOR THE LUNCH PLUS PROGRAM.
