Jay White, Chairman, called the meeting of the Board of Elections to order.
The meeting was properly noticed and a quorum was present.

Wilkerson made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. The Board approved unanimously.

Ericson made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 13, 2025 meeting. The Board approved unanimously.

Edmond made a motion to deny 5 civilian ballots due to returning after the deadline, 2 pending cure that weren't cured and 2 ballots with incomplete witness information. The Board approved unanimously.

Soles explained the audit of all ballots used and unused, tape and ATV poll book totals and the sample hand to eye count as required by statute and conducted on Wednesday, November 12, 2025 at 10:00. The two precincts balanced.

Edmond made a motion to certify the votes cast as recorded on the abstracts for all contests. The Board approved unanimously

Pursuant to NCGS § 163-292 the Board will conduct a coin toss to decide the winner in the third seat of the Mt. Pleasant commissioner race due to a tie vote after all votes have been counted and a discretionary recount held. Poole declined to choose heads or tails. Meadows chose heads. Chairman White tossed the coin and it came up tails. Poole is declared the winner for the third seat of the Mt. Pleasant commissioner race.

Since there was no other business to come before the Board, Norris made a motion to adjourn at 11:21 am. The Board approved unanimously.
