(1) Call to Order

1.1 Invocation

1.2 Conflict of interest statement

(4) Informational Items

4.1 Education Report

Tammi Remsburg reported that school program reservations are increasing quickly. Schools are participating in Big Sweep on their campuses. The Cabarrus County Fair and Environmental Educators of NC are next on the calendar.

4.2 Supervisor's Communications Report

Tammi Remsburg reminded the supervisors of the Area 8 Fall Meeting in Fallston on October 11. She also reported that the new easement specialist, Amy Cook, will start on Monday.

4.3 Division Funds Report

Chuckie Bass gave updates on the cost share projects. They all are making progress.

4.3A Strap Update

The Division Engineer came out to Coddle Creek and Dutch Buffalo Creek August 10th to prepare for no-rise certification on these two streams. Once the no-rise is approved, the contractor will be contacted. The recent storm has washed the debris from the Coddle Creek site for now, but the sand bar will probably catch more.

4.4 Conservation Easement Report

Daniel McClellan reported that the Wilburn Williams Farm tracts will be sent in to ADFP (state funding) for funding for a conservation easement. The Sam Davis Easement will be reapplied for to the ALE funding. An extension has been given by ADFP for their part of the funding.

4.5 Partner Report

Zach Russell gave a report for NRCS stating that there is additional funding available for the EQIP- Environmental Quality Incentives Program. He encouraged producers to apply.

Rick McSwain mentioned the new Education Position which will be an employee of the NC Foundation for Soil & Water Conservation, with some connection to the NC Association of Soil & Water Conservation Districts. The Association is requesting that districts donate a minimum of \$500 for this position. There will be a presentation at the Area 8 Fall Meeting to explain further. Lots of questions still to be answered. Rick also said that he is currently covering 3 areas and may not be able to make every Board meeting. He also mentioned that the state budget is looking favorable at soil & water conservation.
