- (1) Call to Order
  - a. Vicky Porter started the meeting at 5:28 p.m.
- (2) Invocation
  - a. Tommy Porter gave invocation.
- (3) Conflict of interest statement
  - a.   - a. Partner Report
    - i. Rick McSwain discussed Hurricane Relief donation drive from Soil and Water. He also reminded the board of the Fall Area VII Meeting on October 9, 2024, at 200 Gobbler Way, Stanly, NC. Rick McSwain mentioned that the North Carolina Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts is asking for volunteers to assist with the North Carolina State Fair. Area I Fall Meeting is canceled and Area II Meeting is postponed due to Hurricane Helene.

## f. Conservation Easements Report

- Daniel McClellan said that the Cabarrus County Commissioners approved the District to apply for the Agricultual Growth Zone grant.
- ii. The Commissioners also approved for the District to reapply for two conservation easements previously applied in 2023. Amy Cook and Daniel McClellan will apply for federal and state money to assist with the conservation easement applications.
- iii. Daniel McClellan said that the Sam Davis easement is in the preliminary stages of surveying.
- iv. Vicky Porter and Daniel McClellan discussed a potential mentor program for residents that apply for conservation easements.
